



MUSIC Scholarships and Bursaries YEAR 7 - 12 FOR 2010

GENERAL INFORMATION

Music Scholarships and Instrumental/Vocal Bursaries are available to girls in Year 7-12 in 2009. Music Scholarships and Bursaries are awarded based on musical excellence as well as the current needs within the PLC Music Department.

Students applying for a Music Scholarship or Bursary will be required to sit a music aptitude test. Details of the test will be sent out on receipt of the application form.

Students wishing to apply for a Music Scholarship for Year 6 and Year 8 are required to register for the ACEP Academic Scholarship Entrance Examination. Applicants will not be considered unless they have participated in this examination. Students entering Years 9-12 in 2009 who are applying for a Music Scholarship will need to provide documentation on academic achievement.

Based on the applications submitted and results of the music aptitude test some applicants will be invited to audition.

All applicants will be notified by mail as to whether they are required to audition.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS INFORMATION

Music Scholarships provide free instrument/vocal tuition and remission of a percentage of academic fees. The Music lesson component includes 32 x 40 minute individual lessons and instrument hire if necessary. The Scholarship is available for 2010 but may be extended to include music tuition and academic fees in future years based on a satisfactory yearly review.

MUSIC BURSARY INFORMATION

Up to ten Music Bursaries available in 2010. Each Bursary provides free instrument/vocal tuition and includes 32 x 40 minute individual lessons and instrument hire if necessary. The Bursary is available for 2009 but may be extended to include tuition fees in future years based on a satisfactory yearly review.

TERMS OF MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP AND BURSARIES

Music Scholarship/Bursary holders will be expected to:

- be a member of instrument/vocal ensemble(s) as appropriate
- take classroom music in Year 8-12
- maintain a high level of achievement in their chosen area of music study
- be fully supportive and contribute to the musical life at PLC
